VA Clinic Moving to New Facility

VALDOSTA, GA. Area Veterans will soon have access to a new and larger Veterans Affairs (VA) Clinic. On Tuesday, August 4, 2020 the doors will open at the new Valdosta VA Community Based Outpatient Clinic (CBOC). The clinic is located at 348 Enterprise Drive, Suite B, Valdosta, Georgia, 31601.

The new 13,165 square feet clinic will include the following services: Primary Care, Mental Health, Specimen Collection, and Telehealth.

“We are excited to provide a new and improved facility to Veterans in Lowndes County and surrounding communities,” said Thomas Wisnieski, Director, North Florida/South Georgia Veterans Health System. Our efforts continue throughout our system to modernize VA facilities in order to meet Veteran’s needs.

From Friday, July 31 thru Monday, August 3 the existing Valdosta CBOC will begin the move of equipment and furnishing to the new facility. The new clinic, beginning August 4, will still have the same main number.
